Paul is now speaking to believers at the church of Philippi. The themes he develops are:

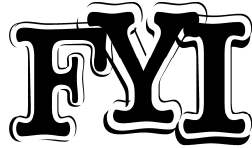
- ◆ Christian citizenship in a tough world

Information regarding the status of the new Multi Ministry Building

Although we are 99.9% done, we are not yet able to use the facility for official regular activities. The two key issues keeping us from obtaining a Certificate of Occupancy are:

1. Waiting for “panic” hardware for a few more doors (these will arrive this week).
2. A successful sprinkler system test. The fire monitoring/sprinkler system is fully operational and functional, but we are working with the City to provide an adequate water supply to this system.
