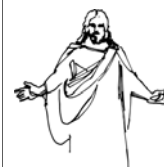

All members and attendees are welcome to join us as we discuss the plans for the next year. Election of officers and voting on next year's budget will take place, as well.



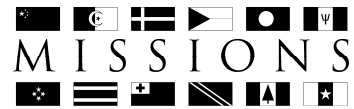
